



Payment Options for TACA Football

The actual cost for an athlete to play a season of football is about \$1,000 per player. Local and corporate sponsorships benefit all of our players and offset our costs. In addition, TACA offers three payment options for the unsponsored portion of these fees. By our young men fundraising, they are relieving their parents of the cost, as it is TACA's desire is to turn out financially responsible young men.

Option 1

- I elect to pay the entire cost of TACA Football as any fundraising efforts are without obligation.
- Enclosed is my payment of the full cost of \$599.
- Enclosed is my check for the Zero-Cost Equipment Lease Deposit of \$300, that is not cashed & is returned when all equipment is returned at season's end.

Option 2

- I elect to pay a registration fee of \$199.
- I completely understand that my player will be obligated to sell \$300 worth of raffle tickets on behalf of TACA.
- If my player fails to sell his \$300 worth of raffle tickets before the final game of the season, I will lose my fundraising deposit.
- These terms will go into effect and are not reversible 10 days after player registers.
- If a player quits, is removed from the team, or is injured, he still must fulfill his fundraising obligation or surrender the fundraising deposit.
- Enclosed are my nonrefundable registration fee of \$199 and a fundraising deposit of \$300 that will be returned upon completion of our fundraising obligation.
- Enclosed is my check for the Zero-Cost Equipment Lease Deposit of \$300, that is not cashed & is returned when all equipment is returned at season's end.

Option 3

- I completely understand that my player will be obligated to sell \$599 worth of raffle tickets on behalf of TACA.
- If my player fails to sell his \$599 raffle tickets or fails to perform his fundraising before the final game of the season, I will lose my fundraising deposit.
- These terms will go into effect and are not reversible 10 days after player registers.
- If a player quits, is removed from the team, or is injured, he still must fulfill his fundraising obligation or surrender the fundraising deposit.
- Enclosed is my fundraising deposit of \$599 that will be returned upon completion of our fundraising obligation.
- Enclosed is my check for the Zero-Cost Equipment Lease Deposit of \$300, that is not cashed & is returned when all equipment is returned at season's end.
